KEARNEY USBC BOWLING HALL OF FAME KEARNEY, NEBRASKA

The Kearney Bowling Hall of Fame is formed for the purpose of honoring past and present members and sponsors of the Kearney USBC*. Those bowlers and sponsors who are inducted into the Hall of Fame shall be recognized for their bowling accomplishments, sportsmanship, promotion, leadership, and/or outstanding contribution to the game of bowling in the city of Kearney.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Kearney USBC's Board of Directors shall be the governing body that will regulate and enforce the requirements needed to become a member of the Hall of Fame. Any business that pertains to the Kearney USBC Hall of Fame shall be directed to the Board of Directors.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Board of Directors shall appoint a selection committee consisting of no fewer than three people. The Selection Committee shall be responsible for reviewing possible candidates for nomination to the Hall of Fame. Their review will include (but not restricted to) a formal nomination application. No nominee being considered for induction to the Hall of Fame shall be allowed to serve on the selection committee or vote on the final candidates.

INDUCTION REQUIREMENTS

The Board of Directors is empowered to select inductees for the Kearney USBC Bowling Hall of Fame in accordance but not limited to the following requirements:

1. To be eligible the nominee must have been or is currently a Kearney USBC* sanctioned bowler in good standing.
2. The nominee shall become a member of the Hall of Fame with a two thirds (2/3) majority vote of the present members of the Kearney USBC Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall be considered a quorum with 75% of its members present to vote on the nominee. If no nominee receives two thirds (2/3) majority vote, the nominee receiving the most votes shall become a member of the Hall of Fame.
3. A bowler is not eligible for induction into the Hall of Fame until ten(10) years after they first become a member of Kearney USBC*.
4. There shall be no less than one (1) or no more than four (4) inductees and/or no more than two(2) sponsors inducted into the Hall of Fame every other year.

There shall be an induction ceremony established to honor those inductees inducted into the Hall of Fame. Those being inducted shall be honored guests and they will receive an award at that time.

Letters of recommendation and nomination applications for those nominees not inducted in the current year shall be held on file for a period of four (4) years for consideration of induction in those years.

*NOTE: Reference to Kearney USBC includes the current association and any previous associations. These include: Kearney USBC BA, Kearney USBC WBA, Kearney BA, and Kearney Women's BA.
